First Aid Measures	Inhalation – Move the person to fresh air Skin – In the event that irritation occurs use soap or proprietary cleanser and wash carefully Eyes – Dust particles should be removed with clean water Ingestion – For discomfort seek medical attention.

Low visibility due to soot, smoke contains carbon monoxide and other harmful gases – avoid inhalation (seek medical assistance if inhaled) Fire extinguishing equipment – waterspray (fog) Foam, CO2 Dry Powder Self contained breathing apparatus should be used by firefighters
Storage and Handling	Store away from ignition such as open flames, torches, electric heaters Do not stack more than 2.4metres. It is recommended that mechanical lifting equipment is provided
Exposure Controls and Personal Protection	Inhalation – Where dust is created is recommend that extraction is used, eye protection and dust masks should be used when cutting. Hands – Gloves should be worn when handling the product Eyes – Eye protection should be worn when cutting the boards, In bright conditions UV protective glasses should be worn Skin – It is advisable that suitable sun block should be worn in sunny weather Other – Access work should not be carried out on un-supported boards.
